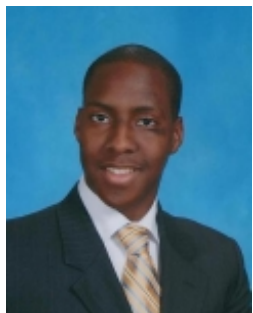

Phillip N. Mathangani
